The Museum of the San Ramon Valley is excited to announce our 2025 Schoolhouse Soirée at the historic Tassajara One Room School. Once more, anticipate a one-of-a-kind evening, blending casual charm with an elegant ambiance. This event will take place al fresco, amidst the picturesque grounds encircling the Tassajara School House, also known as the One Room School House, situated at 1650 Finley Road in Danville. This historic schoolhouse served as an educational hub for four generations of San Ramon Valley children, spanning from 1889 to 1946.

The Schoolhouse now is owned and operated by The Museum and functions as part of a living history curriculum experience for 3rd-grade students in the San Ramon Valley Unified School District, Valley private schools, and home-schooled children.

In addition, we have the First Peoples of California program designed and executed by the museum to meet the curriculum requirements for the 4th grade. This hands-on program teaches about the first residents of the Valley dating back 12,000 years.

The museum showcases an ambitious annual exhibit schedule, delving into a diverse array of topics that captivate learners of all ages, from school-age children to high school, college, and adult audiences. Each subject explored intricately intertwines with the rich history of the Valley.

The museum is well known for its exhibits. An example of the exhibits over the past years are:

- The Chinese and the Iron Road

- The Art of Survival: The Japanese American Internment Experience During WW2
- Cowboys and Cattleman: Ranching in the San Ramon Valley
- Stir Crazy Quilts: Quilting During the Pandemic

These types of exhibits are made possible by underwriters who fund them.

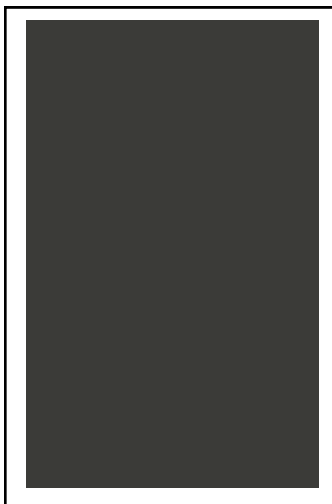

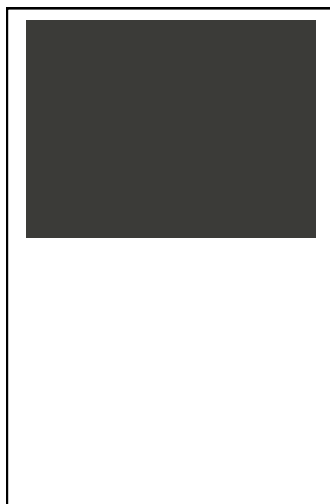

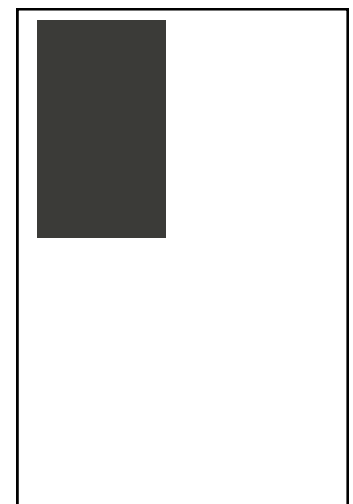
